


INTRODUCTION OF NEW CRYPTIC PARTICIPANTS

Potential participant completes an application form (Schedule 1) outlining proposal, available either via website or from Oxford team if contacted directly



Submitted to Oxford team

Oxford circulates the proposal to Executive Committee for review on a quarterly basis. Decisions on whether the new participant is eligible for admittance will be made within thirty (30) days of receipt and based on requirements of the consortium, proposed contribution of data and data quality. If necessary, the EC will seek advice from Data Oversight Board and General Assembly Members.



Application passed onto the General Assembly for review. Objections must be made within 30 days of receipt. If no objections are raised, the party will be admitted. If objections are raised, the General Assembly will be asked to vote whether the party should be admitted to the project in accordance with General Assembly terms.



Oxford provides feedback to potential new participant and starts contractual proceedings (Accession Form or Data Sharing Agreement)
